Anti Ragging Notice

As per UGC guidelines the Chairpersons of all the teaching Departments and the Wardens of the Hostels are required to comply with the following directions to check ragging incidents. Action on the directions should be taken as and when required due to unprecedented situation:

- Display of Helpline Number,
- 2. In compliance of the 2nd Amendment in UGC regulations, all Chairpersons/Directors/Coordinators of Panjab University Departments are requested to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit on line undertaking every academic year at www.antiragging.in & www.amanmovement.org, in addition to the mandatory undertaking submitted by all students/parents as hard-copy.
- Mentoring Cell in the departments as well as in the hostels.
- 4. Security Staff under direct control of Chairperson/Warden.
- Lodging of FIR sole responsibility of Chairperson/Warden where incident occurs.
- 6. Display of punishments to be given in case any person found in ragging.
- Weekly reports to DSW who will forward the same to Vice-Chancellor through DUI.
- Migration certificate or Character Certificate to be issued by the Chairperson, who
 specifically mentions the role of the student in ragging, if detected and such students
 will also not be eligible for any financial gain/benefits sanctioned to him.
- In compliance of the 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:
 - "Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background".
- 10. The UGC has got developed 4 short films and a documentary film to counsel students on ill effects of ragging. These films are uploaded on UGC website. The Chairpersons
 - of all the Teaching Departments are requested to show these films regularly to the students during orientation and other programmes. These movies are available on the following link ugc.ac.in/page/Video-Regarding-Ragging.aspx. Due to unprecedented situation, the students be advised to see these movies and go through the ingredients/forms of ragging and punishment at their own on the UGC web site.

Other Duties assigned to Wardens

- Additional security staff to be obtained for initial three months and put on duty in each block of the hostel.
- Hostel Raids Committee consisting of Wardens, one of senior resident and teacher of the department, whose students are admitted in the Hostel.
- No darkness in or around the hostels.
- Not to conceal anything.
- Warden accessible at all hours.
- 16. During first three months anonymous random survey by the Warden/Team.
- 17. Effective Warden would be awarded by the UGC Committee.

A copy each of the Undertaking to be submitted by the student and parent/guardian together with a poster depicting the forms of ragging and punishments is enclosed for supply to the **new** as well as old candidates/students after getting the required number thereof Xeroxed at the level of Department & Hostel. It be ensured that admission in the Department/Hostel is allowed only after the mandatory undertaking is submitted by the students at the time of admission.
